Achievement of the Ministry of Civil Aviation Milestone Legislation Bharatiya Vayuyan Adhiniyam 2024 Enacted

January 2025

The Bharatiya Vayuyan Adhiniyam 2024, introduced by the Minister of Civil Aviation Sh. Ram Mohan Naidu, was passed by Lok Sabha on 09.08.2024 and by Rajya Sabha on 05.12.2024. This landmark legislation replaces the colonial–era Aircraft Act of 1934, aiming to modernize India's aviation sector. It streamlines regulatory processes, fosters indigenous manufacturing under the 'Make in India' initiative, and aligns with international conventions like the Chicago Convention and ICAO standards. The Act came into force on January 1, 2025.
